

The MMXI Classical Literacy Exam

In MMXI, almost 800 students participated in the Second Annual Classical Literacy Exam. These students were from 29 schools in 16 states across the United States and also from Australia.

During the first week of February, these 800 students took the Classical Literacy Exam in their respective schools. Included in these schools were public schools, private schools, charter schools, and homeschools.

Below is the breakdown of awards for each level of the Classical Literacy Exam. Each place is determined by the correct number of answers out of fifty. The students who achieved a Perfect score in the Introductory exam were awarded purple ribbons. A Perfect score in Levels I-III was recognized with a Perfect medal, and a Gold score in Levels I-III was recognized with a Gold medal.
